❖ **In-term Swimming Lessons**

In-term swimming is held at the Northam Aquatic Facility. Students who have a season pool pass are not required to pay entry fee. The Season Pool pass must be supplied with the permission slip.

Students will walk to and from the pool, thereby alleviating the need for a bus fee.

❖ **Sporting Event Entry/Bus Fee**

The sporting event fee is payable for students to attend sporting events such as Faction/Interschool carnivals and trials if a bus is used to transport students, or the facility charges an entry fee.

❖ **Incursions/Excursions**

The School Council recognises the value of incursions for students and seeks to support teachers who co-ordinate them as part of their teaching programs.

❖ **Year 6 Camp**

Each year teachers offer to co-ordinate a camp for year 6 students. The School Council has agreed that the maximum charge to parents for any official camp should not exceed the figure shown. Year 6 teachers look to subsidise the cost of camp through fundraising.

❖ **Year 6 Leavers Ceremony**

The Year 6 students have an opportunity to attend a leaver's ceremony and a charge is requested to provide a meal/disco after the ceremony.

❖ **Year 6 Leavers Shirt**

Students are given the opportunity to purchase a "leavers shirt" to wear in their last year of primary school. The Year 6 teachers will consult with students on design and order during Term 4 of the previous year and Term 1.

❖ **PEAC**

Selected PEAC students may have the opportunity to participate in excursions during the school year.

❖ **Instrumental Music**

Students sit a music test in year 4 for the opportunity to attend instrumental music lessons through School of Instrumental Music (SIM) in years 5 & 6. Instruments are hired through the school at a cost of \$110 per year. An additional \$30 is budgeted for excursions/text books/etc. as required.

Personal Items

Dress Code:

Parents/Carers are required to send their children in full school uniform. Uniforms may be purchased through Cadd's Fashions Sportsfirst Northam, Fitzgerald St, Northam. Some second hand uniforms are available through the school office or the Red Cross shop.

Hats

Hats are compulsory all year.

Students are required to wear the *school hat* which is available for purchase from Cadd's Fashions Sportsfirst Northam.

Faction Shirts

Northam Primary has 'Faction Fridays'. Each Friday students are encouraged to wear a faction shirt. Faction shirts may be purchased through any supplier.

Personal Items Requirements Years K – 6:

These items (listed on following pages) may be purchased from any supplier.

There is a pre-order opportunity available through the P&C in which the P&C receive a commission. If you wish to use the pre-order process, please ensure you return the order forms by the allocated date (usually Oct of the previous year). All items should be labelled individually with your child's name.

It is preferable that stationery requirements are supplied in full at the beginning of the year. Teachers will then distribute to students as required. Numbers of items listed are estimated; it does not take into consideration lost items. Sometimes there may be a need for replacement through the year.

Sunscreen

Parents are asked to supply sunscreen for their child/ren. Sunscreen is an important part of our SunSmart policy and students are required to apply prior to going outside during play times or physical education lessons. You may wish to purchase a small bottle that connects to their school bag, which you can fill as required.

Headphones

With the increased need for the use of technologies in schools and the increased need for COVID hygiene practices, parents are asked to supply a set of headphones for their child/ren personal use. Headphones should be child's over the ear style, volume limited. These can be purchased from any supplier. Please ensure headphones are clearly marked with your child's name.

Student Uniform and Dress Code Policy

All students in Western Australia attending government schools are required to wear a school uniform, this applies to all students attending Northam Primary School. This policy is supported by our School Council. School uniform is important because it:

- Instils pride in the school
- Gives students a sense of belonging
- Encourages identification with Northam Primary School
- Promotes a sense of equality amongst students
- Increases safety while walking to and from school or on excursions, making identification of students easier
- Is cost effective for parents and care givers.

All students of Northam Primary School must wear full school uniform. Any exemptions must be cleared through the Principal. The uniform consists of:

- School polo shirt,
- School jacket/jumper,
- Royal blue track pants,
- Royal blue skort/shorts/dress (should be at a modest length),
- Wide brimmed school hat (other hats such as caps etc. are not to be worn)
- Faction shirt,
- Year 6 School Leavers Polo shirt, and
- Footwear: Shoes, sneakers or plain low sandals, strapped to the foot. Flat shoes for girls are appropriate. Safety is important, (Thongs, reef sandals, massage sandals, heeled dress sandals, heeled boots, flat heeled boots and scuffs are not permitted).

Tights and long socks are only to be worn if they are in the Royal Blue, unless on a special occasion such as crazy sock day.

The wearing of cosmetics is not acceptable this includes any form of makeup, face covering, nail polish, fake nails or temporary tattoos.

Hair needs to be neat and tidy. Hair that is collar length or longer must be tied up.

A watch and either studs or sleepers, and a single chain with a small pendent can be worn. Other items of jewellery may not to be worn for safety reasons. The school will not be responsible for lost or damaged jewellery.

If a student does not meet the requirements of the Northam Primary School dress code these steps will be followed:

- The classroom teacher will explain to the student the need to be in uniform and will send them to the office to borrow the uniform item from the school.
- Issues regarding non-compliance, or requests for exemptions from the dress code must be referred to the principal.

Here are some guidelines to assist parents and students.

- If students are not following the dress code they may be unable to attend whole school activities such as excursions/incursions etc.
- Students are required to be clean and tidy in appearance. At all times, clothing should conform to standards of modesty acceptable to the school.
- Board shorts, skate pants and similarly styled garments are not suitable.
- Beanies are NOT part of the school dress code.
- NO DENIM. Jeans are not acceptable.
- Sun smart: The school implements a No School Hat, No Play policy.

Exemptions

All students are expected to meet dress requirements unless an exemption has been granted. The grounds for exemption or modification relate to student health, ethnic considerations, religion or any other matter which, in the principal's opinion, is sufficient to exempt a student from dress code requirements. The exemption must be negotiated with the principal at the time of enrolment. Provision for temporary exemptions will be made to accommodate new students and the non-availability of components of dress code items, or where there is significant change to student circumstances. A copy of any exemption record will be provided to the student, parents and teachers, and placed on the students file.
